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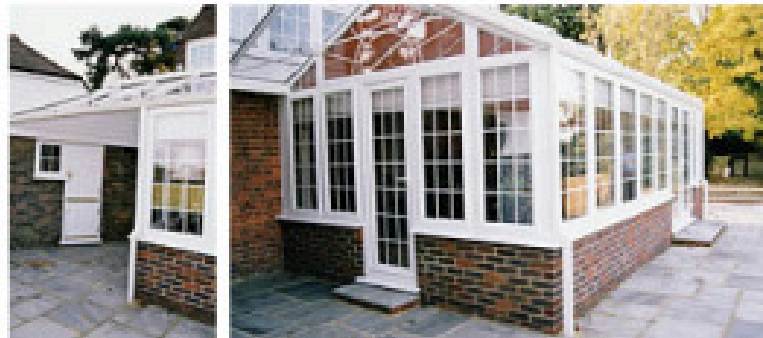
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Our Installations - Case Study 1



Location: Hawkhurst, Kent

Domestic Requirement: Large conservatory with covered walkway to garage

Crittall Recommendation: Large conservatory with linked roof elements, 6.8m x 3.8m to provide a link between the house and detached garage block

Detail: The roofline was extended to provide a covered walkway to the garage, the roof pitch being set level with the bottom edge of the existing shiplap cladding used on the upper aspect of the exterior walls

Material Requirement: Virtually maintenance free PVC-U

Design Requirement: Georgian bar glazing panels to reflect the style of the existing building

Special Design Considerations: Symmetrical design with all frames to the front elevation of equal size

Product Requirement: Edwardian Gable-style roofing system
Specialist Goldline glazing and beading for the gable ends
Fixed window panels, top hung opening vents and doors in Goldline 'All White' (including gaskets and white spacer bar)

Construction: Dwarf wall construction

Result: Used for informal dining in addition to providing an extra sitting room with magnificent views

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
